#### **SPONSOR CERTIFICATES**

Sponsor Certificates are often required before one can serve as a Godparent for the Sacrament of Baptism or as a Sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation. In order to receive a Sponsor Certificate from Holy Rosary, one needs to be a Registered Parishioner of the Parish, have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, must be over 14 years of age and if married must be in a valid Church marriage (have been married in the presence of a priest/deacon and two witnesses).

Sponsor Certificates may be obtained only **AFTER** any of the Sunday Masses.


The PERSON REQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE MUST see the Priest AFTER ATTENDING THE MASS and request one.
